Born in Melzo (Mi), on May, 14, 1962. He graduated as Doctor in Dental Surgery at the University of Milan in 1986.

From 1989 to 2000 he was Clinical Instructor, then Assistant Professor at the Department of Medicine, Surgery and Dentistry S.Paolo, University of Milan.

From 2000 he is Associate Professor at the University of Milan where he is course director for Restorative Dentistry (Riabilitazione Orale I), graduation course in Dentistry and Dental Prosthetics, Faculty of Medicine and Surgery.

From 2012 he is Director of the Restorative and Endodontics Department, Dental section of the IRCCS Galeazzi Orthopedic Institute.

He's member in the Commission for the assessment of extra-CEE graduations.

He has contributed to National research projects (CNR) for the study of disease factors involved in the dental caries prevention.

He collaborated to the European Union Research Framework COST program, Action B8 – Odontogenesis (1996), Operative Unit I1, actions WG3 and 4.
